MOVEMENT LEADERSHIP

May 9 - 11

Shenandoah National Park

We'll lay the groundwork by reflecting on our roles in the social change ecosystem and white supremacy culture, analyzing power dynamics within social movements, and envisioning Virginia's future.

STORYTELLING + NARRATIVE July 11 - 13 Harrisonburg

This retreat will begin and end with storytelling about our past and future, with a primary focus on narrative change through framing, messaging, audience analysis, and strategy evaluation.

COMMUNITY ORGANIZING

June 13 - 15 Culpeper

Focusing on relational organizing, we'll examine how organizing can create political homes through basebuilding, leadership development, campaign design, and movement strategy.

MONEY + CAPITAL August 15 - 17 Richmond

We'll dive into emerging practices in fundraising and the solidarity economy, including communitycentered fundraising, trust-based philanthropy, mutual aid, and capital strategies.
